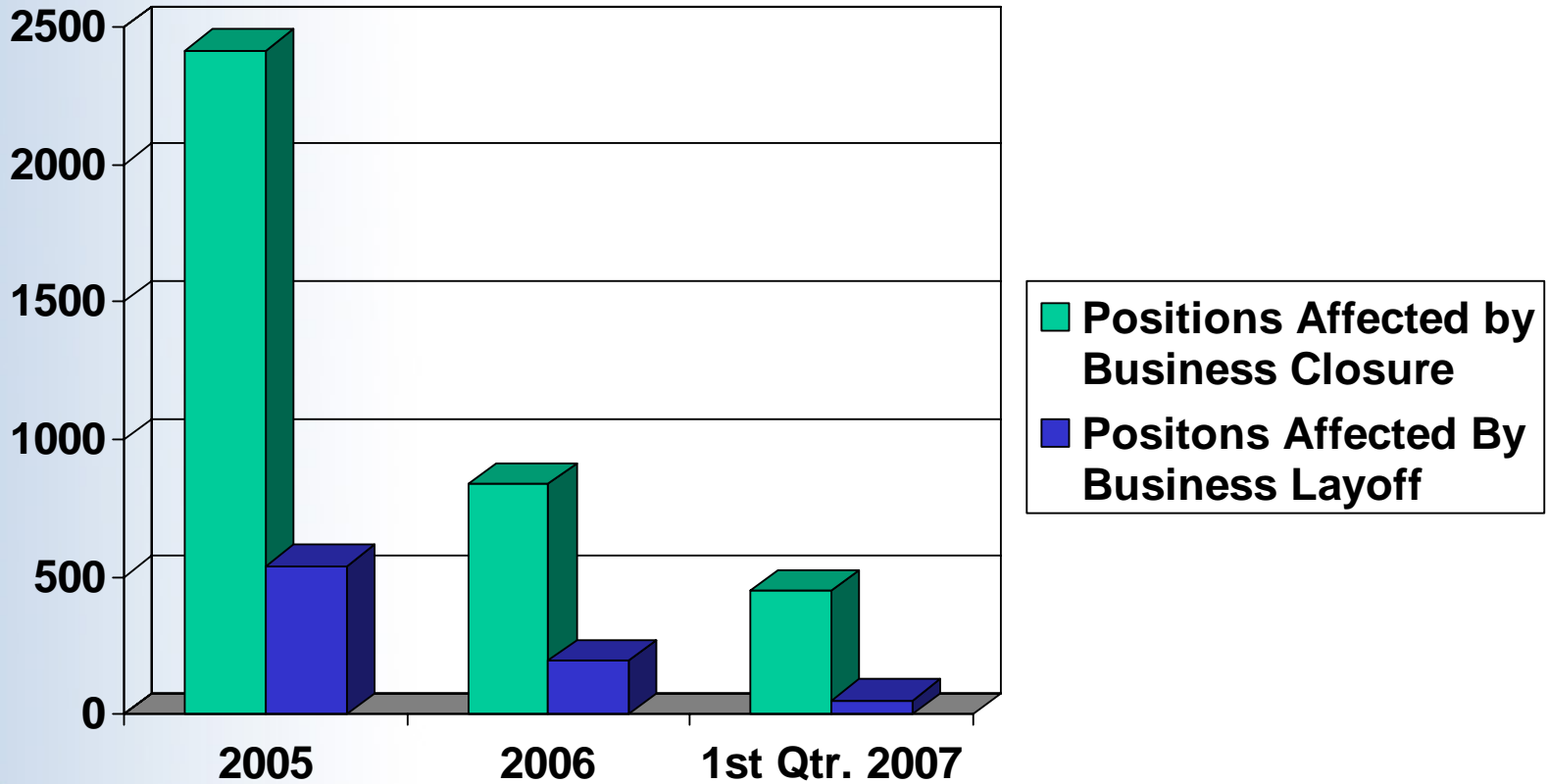
Pendleton Workforce Investment Area Closure/Layoff Notifications Summary 2005 – 1st Quarter 2007

- 3,701 positions were affected due to business **closure**.
- 791 positions were affected due to business **layoff**.
- **Textile Manufacturing** reported the greatest number of positions affected at 1,955 due to layoff/closure.
- **Oconee County** reported 2,583 positions affected – the highest at the county level in WIA due to layoff/closure.



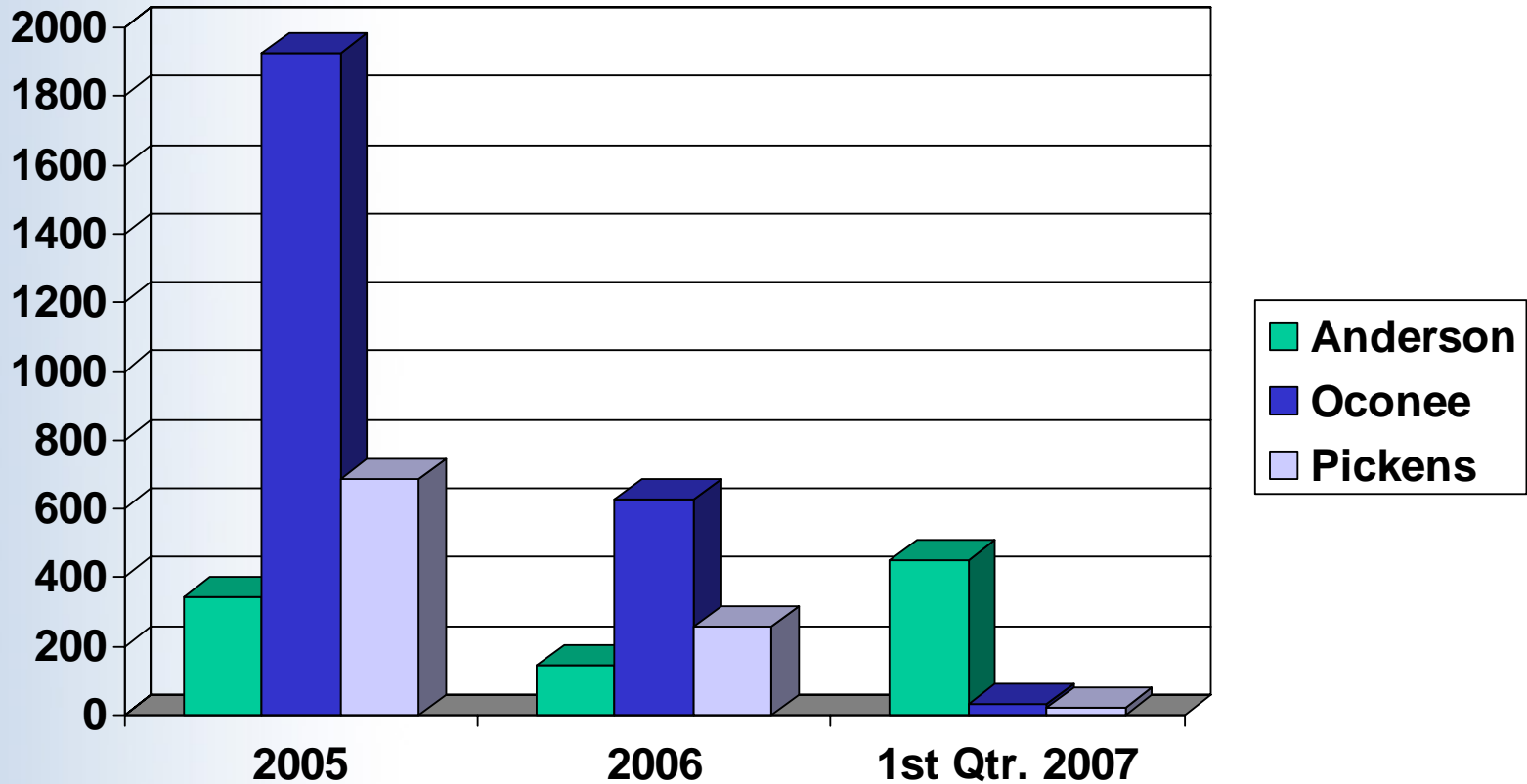


Pendleton WIA Positions Affected: by Business Closure/Layoff Classification by Year



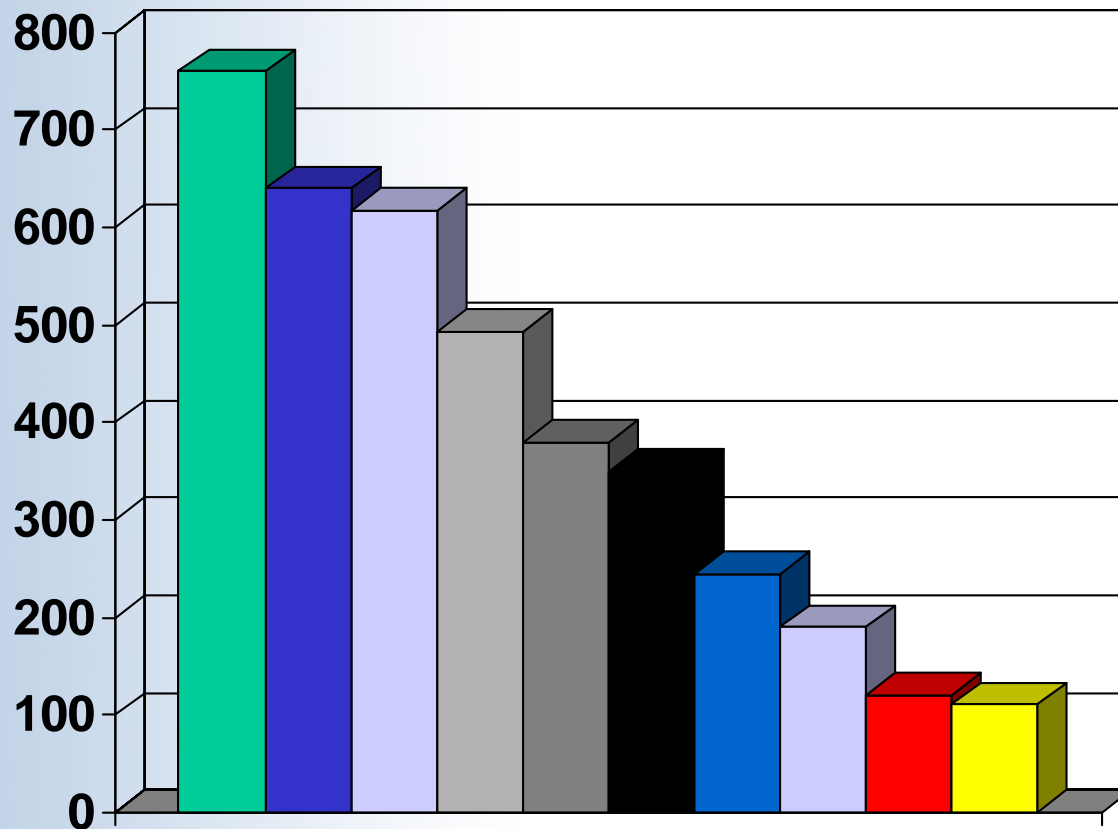


Pendleton WIA Positions Affected: by County Classification by Year





Pendleton WIA Positions Affected: by NAICS Title Classification Years 2005 -2007 1st. Qtr.

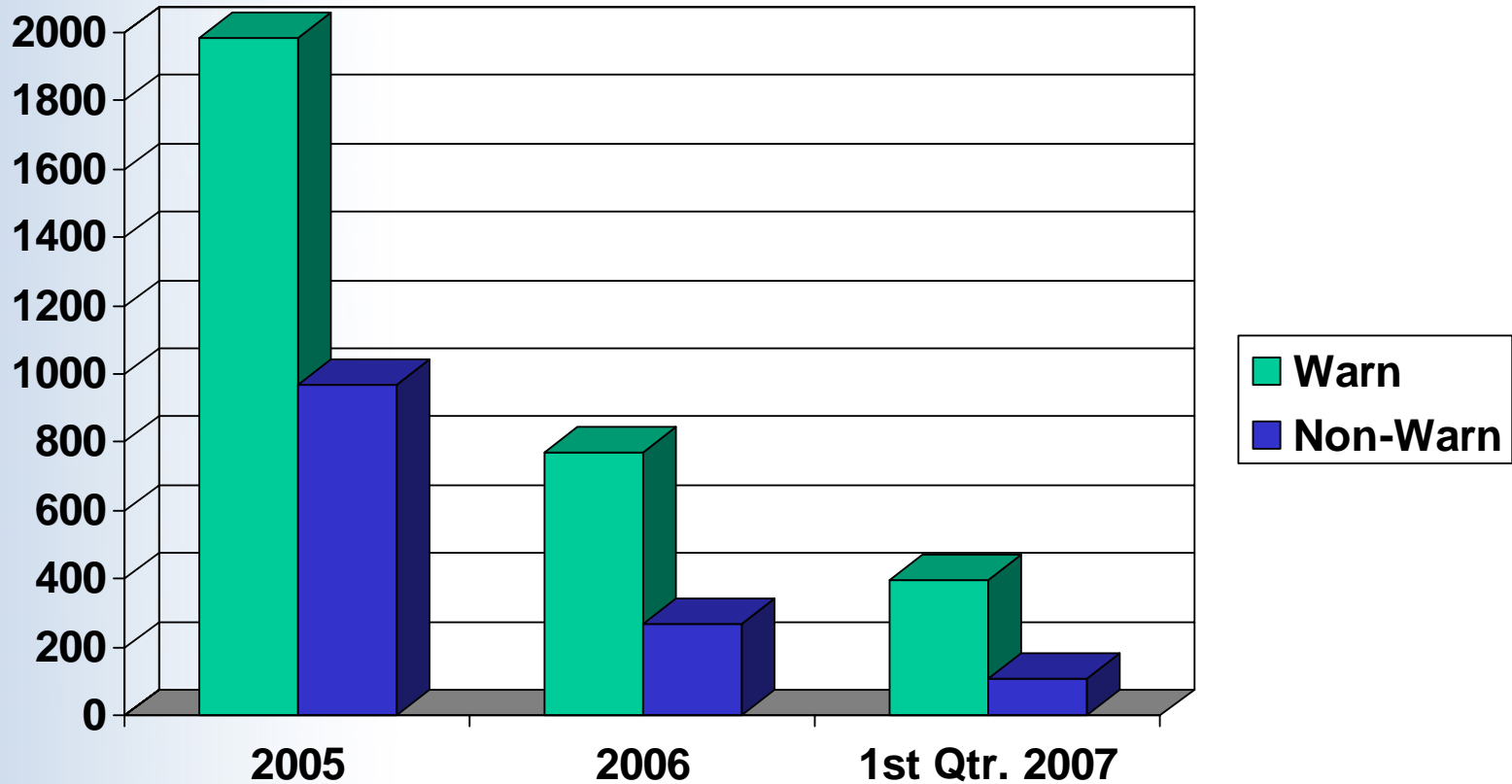
